(For A-bomb Exhibit and Peace Education Materials)

- 1. The applicant shall use the materials only as specified in the application (event, purpose, time period, venue, etc.). Any use of the materials beyond that specified in the application requires a new application.

- 3. Regarding the "Hiroshima" booklet, please print the data and use it as a hard copy, and discard the data after printing. Uploading the data without permission is strictly prohibited.
- 4. The Museum will pay for outbound shipping only. The "Hiroshima-Nagasaki Atomic Bomb Poster Set" is generally shipped by Surface Air Lifted (SAL).
- 5. The Museum is not responsible for any failure to deliver or delay in delivery caused by any event reasonably beyond the control of the Museum.
- 6. Loaned materials must be returned to the Museum's Outreach Division immediately after use.
- 7. The applicant must submit a Material Utilization Report after using the materials.
