

## **Terms and Conditions**

### **(For A-bomb Exhibit and Peace Education Materials)**

1. The user shall only use the materials as stated in the application (event, purpose, time period, venue, etc). A new application will be required for use of the materials beyond what is stated in the application.
2. All content materials—text, photos, images, designs, everything—are the copyright of the Hiroshima Peace Memorial Museum (hereafter the Museum), original copyright owners, or filmmakers. Any reproduction, modification, duplication, transmission or distribution of the material, for personal or commercial use, whether in whole or in part, without expressed permission is strictly prohibited.
3. For “Posters of Sadako and Paper Cranes (26 posters),” the user is responsible for all shipping costs. The Museum ships COD (FedEx or DHL) for outgoing shipments.
4. For other materials, the Museum will cover only the outgoing shipping fee. The “Hiroshima-Nagasaki Atomic Bomb Poster Set” will be delivered by SAL.
5. The Museum will not be responsible for any failure to deliver or delay in delivery caused by any event reasonably beyond its control.
6. Loan materials must be promptly returned to the Outreach Division of the Museum after use.
7. The user must submit a Material Utilization Report after use of the materials.
8. The user must assume responsibility for any loss of, or damage to the materials during the loan period, unless otherwise stated by the Museum.
9. The applicant shall undertake full responsibility for any problems or issues resulting from use of the materials.
